NEXT STEP IN TAMWORTH GLOBAL GATEWAY PARK UNDERWAY

Works on the trunk stormwater drainage infrastructure at the Tamworth Global Gateway Park are underway with boots hitting the worksite on the 15th of February.

Member for Tamworth welcomed the key stage in the construction of the \$31.935 million multi-stage business, industrial and enterprise project.

"The Tamworth Global Gateway Park will be huge for the people of the Tamworth Region," Mr Anderson said.

"The project will transform unused land into a bustling business, industrial and enterprise district positioned on roads that connect Tamworth to the west.

"The NSW Government has invested \$20.24 million in the project which will support regional growth and economic development.

"The project will also house the Tamworth Intermodal Freight Facility. When that project and its accompanying railway line are completed, Tamworth will have a direct rail route to Port Botany.

"This will give producers and commercial operators in the New England Northwest a direct transport supply chain to customers around the world.

NSW Deputy Premier John Barrilaro said the project was a part of the NSW National Party's 20 year Economic Vision for Regional NSW.

"We are investing in regional infrastructure, programs and services that support industry development, improve productivity and economic growth."

This stage of the development also includes works to widen Goddard Lane which commenced in November 2020.
