Tamworth Intermodal Rail Line

The NSW Government is reactivating five kilometres of non-operational rail line between West Tamworth and Westdale. Reactivation of the rail line will allow rail access to the Tamworth Regional Freight Terminal to be located near Goddards Lane. The project is funded by the Restart NSW Fund.

Main construction works started in January 2021, and is scheduled to finish in late 2021.

Upcoming work

Work will continue in June, weather permitting, and includes:

- Reactivation of level crossing at Gunnedah Road
- Reactivation of level crossing at Dampier Street
- Installing steel structures to low level bridges
- Constructing utility protection slabs
- Constructing the new track with ballast, sleepers and rail line
- Planned public road closures to Gunnedah Rd and Dampier St to upgrade the level rail crossing
- Commencing signals construction at Gunnedah Road.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, loaders, smooth drum rollers, franna cranes and hand tools.

Hours of work

Construction will be carried out Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm and Saturday from 8am to 1pm.

Notification of weekend work - June and July 2021

Work to reactivate three level crossings along the rail corridor at Gunnedah Road, Dampier Street and Evans Street will be carried out in June and July 2021.

These works will include the installation of boom gates, flashing lights and bells. The bells will operate on a timer so they will not activate between the hours of 10pm and 6am.

At this stage, all works are expected to be completed during the day, between 7am and 6pm.

Proposed staging for these works, weather permitting:

- Gunnedah Road 23 June to 25 June 2021
- Dampier Street 26 June to 27 June 2021
- Evans Street 17 July to 18 July 2021.

During these works, the roads will be closed and diversions will be in place. Detour signs and variable message signs will be in place to advise motorists of detours.




Image: Detours will be in place around the work site on Dampier Street and Gunnedah Road.
