

Tamworth Intermodal Rail Line

The NSW Government is reactivating five kilometres of non-operational rail line between West Tamworth and Westdale. Reactivation of the rail line will allow rail access to the Tamworth Regional Freight Terminal to be located near Goddards Lane. The project is funded by the Restart NSW Fund.

Main construction works started in January 2021 and are scheduled to finish in late 2021.

Upcoming work

Work will continue in July, weather permitting, and includes:

- Upgrade of level rail crossing on Evans Street
- Constructing new track between Dampier and Evans Streets, including ballast, sleepers and rail
- Welding of rail lengths will continue
- Construction of rail signals at Gunnedah Road, Dampier Street and Evans Street.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, loaders, smooth drum rollers, welders and resurfacing plant.

Hours of work

Construction will be carried out **Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm** and **Saturday from 8am to 1pm**.

Permanent closure of pedestrian level crossing between Gunnedah Road and Bridge Street

The pedestrian level crossing between Gunnedah Road and Bridge Street will be permanently closed on **31 July 2021**.

The closure will protect pedestrians from rail traffic on the reactivated rail line once the line is operational.

The nearest alternate pedestrian level crossing is located 800m west on Denison Street.

Notification of weekend work – 17 and 18 July 2021

Work to reactivate the rail level crossing at Evans Street will be carried out on **17 and 18 July 2021**, weather permitting.

All work is expected to be completed during the day, between **7am and 6pm**.

Work will include the installation of boom gates, flashing lights and bells. The bells will operate on a timer so they will not activate between the hours of 10pm and 6am.

During this work, Evans Street level crossing will be closed and signs and variable message signs will be in place to advise motorists of detours.
