Tamworth Regional Council Policy

BANNING NOTICE POLICY

1. PURPOSE

1.1 As part of Tamworth Regional Council's commitment to meet its duty of care and promote a culture where harm to our people and the community is unacceptable, it recognises and will enforce its right to limit the access and use of properties under its control.

2. COMMENCEMENT OF POLICY

2.1 This policy commenced in 2022 and is revised annually.

3. SCOPE

3.1 This policy applies to all property or premises that Tamworth Regional Council is the lawful owner, occupier or apparently in charge of.

4. COMMITTMENT

- 4.1 In meeting our commitment, Tamworth Regional Council reserves the right to formally revoke the right of any person to enter its premises without lawful excuse, and if appropriate will issue a banning notice in accordance with the *Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901* to any person who is assessed as:
 - 4.1.1 having engaged in unlawful and/or antisocial behaviour and is likely to repeat such behaviour; or
 - 4.1.2 a reasonable and credible threat to the safety and/or wellbeing of any other person on Tamworth Regional Council premises; or
 - 4.1.3 being unable to demonstrate a legitimate reason for being on Tamworth Regional Council premises

This signed statement of Policy confirms our personal commitment to making Tamworth Regional Council workplaces safe and healthy for all its workers.
